What Is Islam?



Founded in Saudi Arabia in 7th century.

By Muhammad – " final great prophet of God"

Islam = "surrender" (to God)

Muslim = "one who surrenders"

What Is Islam?



Islam's Creed The "Shahada" – Statement of Faith

"There is no God but Allah, and Muhammad is His servant and messenger."

Monotheistic – One God

Unquestionably and strictly follows the teachings of Muhammad

The Two Sources of Islamic Truth



Qur'an (Koran)

Claims to be word for word inspired prophecy given to Muhammad by God.

Hadiths (Narrations)

Traditions claiming to tell true stories about Muhammad's life: what he said, did, did not object to.
Muhammad = The "perfect man"



Written by Muhammad over a span of 23 years.

Reflects major changes in his life.



Early years in Mecca (610-622):

Fairly well-to-do merchant.

No great political clout.

Mecca: Center of pagan worship:
"One God" teaching unpopular.
Islam a minority, unpopular religion.
Muhammad and followers
reviled, persecuted, some killed.



Later years in Medina (622-632):

At first, impartial judge in clan disputes.

Quickly became person of influence.

Medina: Large Jewish population
City not as opposed to "one God" doctrine.
Prominent pagan converted, most of
population followed suit.
Muhammad became powerful, rich.
Forced out or killed all 3 Jewish clans.



Later years in Medina (622-632):

Muhammad became a warlord!

Okayed attacks on caravans from Mecca.

Attacked and eventually overthrew Mecca.

Instituted Islamic law.

Armed invasion of Northern and Eastern Arabia, abolished paganism, established Islam as the political and religious government.



What if you were leader of outnumbered, unpopular religious movement with powerful enemies and no protection laws?
