



Sin must be confronted wherever it is found.


A neat thing to be a prophet?


2 Sam. 12:1 - Nathan

2 Tim. 3:16 – Reproof and correction Gal. 2:11-14 – Paul to Peter




Sometimes it is harder to see our own sin than to see others' sin.

Luke 18:11 – Self-righteous

James 2:10 ff. - "But I didn't murder!"

Mat. 7:3-5 – Hypocritical judgment.




The path of recovery from sin begins with recognition.

The value of God's word:

2 Sam. 12:13 - "I have sinned"

Luke 18:13 – "God, be merciful to me, the sinner!"

1 John 1:8-9 - Confession is essential



God meets mourning with mercy.

2 Sam. 12:13 – "The Lord has put away your sin."
