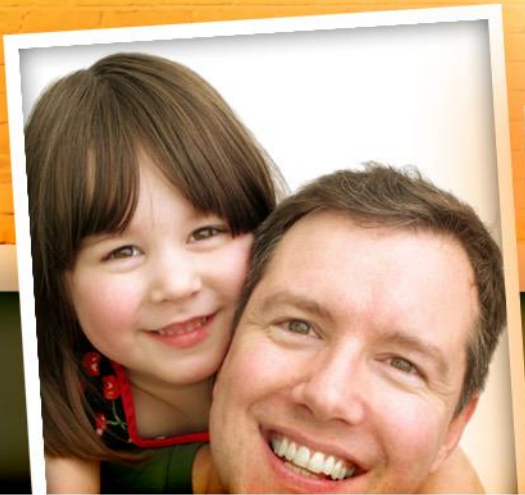


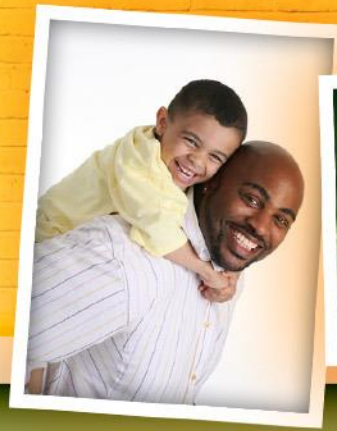

12:4 – The excellent wife of her husband

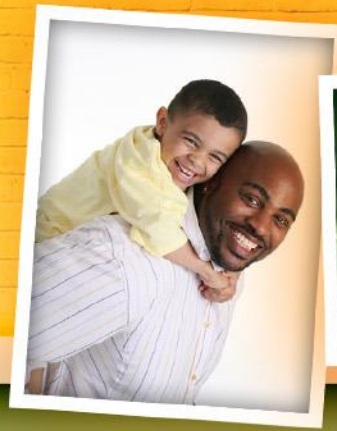

12:4 – The excellent wife of her husband

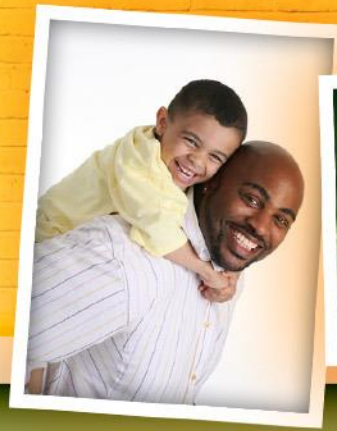

A crown of gold or thorns?

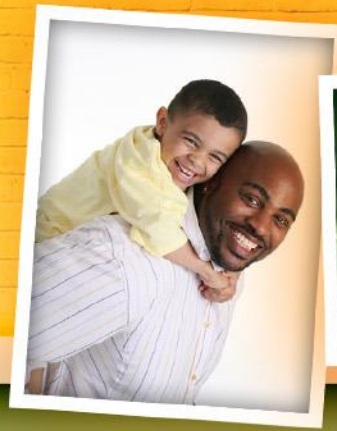

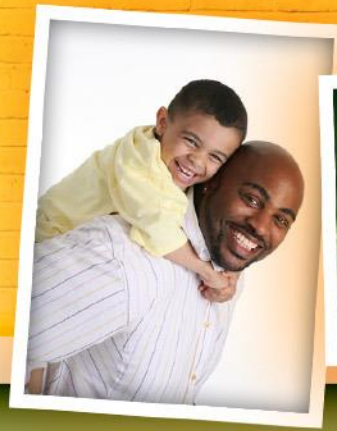
