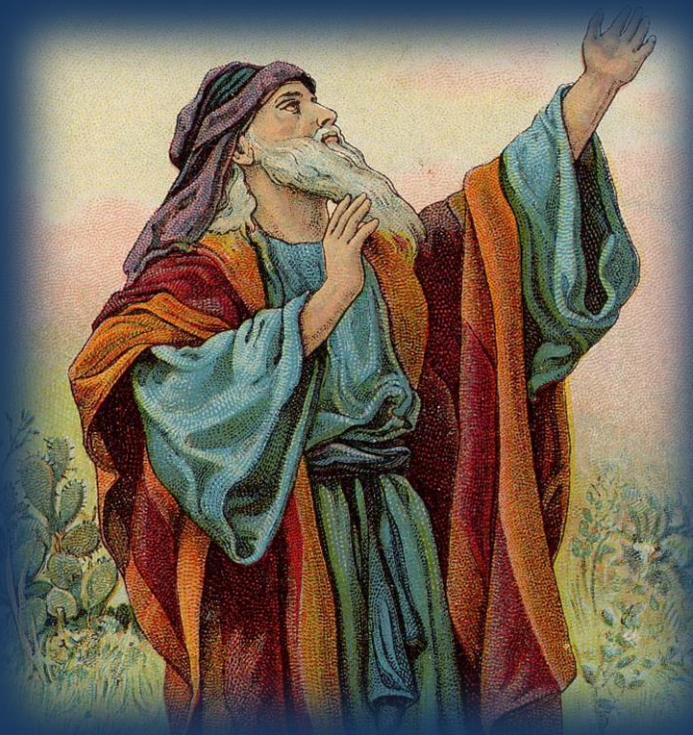

The Thing About Walking With God:

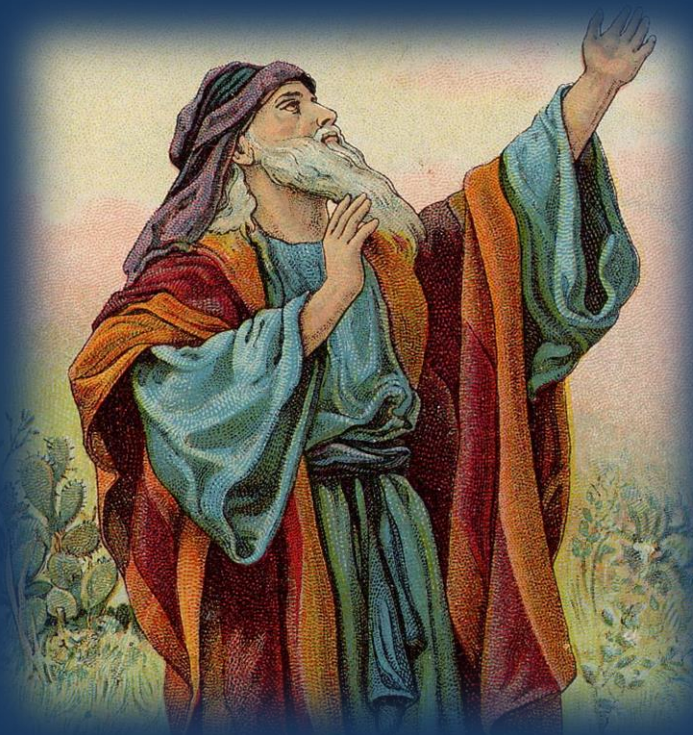
- *It means we do not lag behind or run ahead of God.*

- *It means we walk by faith and not by sight.*

Perhaps: Enoch Walked With God After 65 Years

Gen. 5:22 – “After he begot
Methuselah, Enoch walked with
God 300 years.”

Lessons From Enoch

Marriage.

Birth of child or grandchild.

Death of loved one.

Bad doctor report.



Perhaps: Enoch Walked With God After 65 Years

Enoch's prophecy – Jude 14-15

“Behold, the Lord comes with 10,000 of His saints, to execute judgment on all, to convict all who are ungodly among them of their ungodly deeds which they have committed in an ungodly way, and of all the harsh things which ungodly sinners have spoken against Him.”
