- "Spread your wings over your servant for you are a <u>redeemer</u>"
 - The man who married Ruth had to also buy the land. Lev. 25
 - He also had to be willing to perpetuate the name.

Muth 4 Redemption and Restoration

No Ordinary Marriage Proposal Ruth 3:9

There were limitations on who Ruth could marry. Deut. 25

- He had to be the next of kin
- While Boaz was a close relative he was not the closest. Ruth 3:13

Muth A Redemption and Restoration

Boaz Confronts the RedeemerRuth 4:1-6

Boaz brings the man before the elders and tells him about the land

- At first he agrees to buy the land
- He later declines when he learns about Ruth and the rest of his responsibility

Muth 4
Redemption and Restoration

Boaz Marries RuthRuth 4:7-13

The man surrenders his right and responsibility to Boaz

- The transaction is confirmed
- The people give Boaz their blessing
- Boaz marries Ruth and they have a son

Redemption and Restoration

Naomi is the Great Benefactor Ruth 4:14-22

God uses this situation to bless Naomi by giving her a son!

Three Practical Lessons We Learn from Ruth 4

- God gives and He takes away.
- God is near to those who need Him
- God is at work, don't doubt His providence
