Hear God's Word – John 5:24 – “He who hears my words and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life.”

Believe in Jesus – Mark 16:16 – “He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.”

Repent of your sins – Acts 17:30 – “Truly, these times of ignorance God overlooked, but now commands all men everywhere to repent.”

Confess Jesus as Lord and Christ – Romans 10:10 – “For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.”

Be baptized (immersed in water) – Acts 2:38 – “Repent, and let everyone of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of your sins.”

Continue to be faithful – Revelation 2:10 – “Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life.”

What Must We Confess?

- **Christ before men**
 - We have several examples of Christians who made a confession of Christ
 - It is more than an empty phrase we utter
- **Sin before God and man**
 - We must acknowledge our sin
 - We must resolve to change

When Must We Confess?

- **Whenever it is necessary**
 - Sin, as it occurs
 - Christ, as we are called upon to do so
- **Continually**
 - We must constantly acknowledge who God is and praise Him for it
 - Our life should be a constant confession

Why Must We Confess?

- **So that others will hear and respond**
 - We are to be a light to others
 - Our confession of Christ might ignite faith in someone else
- **So that Christ will confess us**
 - If we confess Christ He will confess us
 - Christ will not be ashamed of us
