God's Mighty Warrior



Judges 6 Israel cries out, God answers. > A prophet to the people: God can deliver you (8-9) The problem is YOU (10) If you choose the path of sin, the way will be hard! – Psa. 1



Judges 6 Israel cries out , God answers. > Angel of the Lord to Gideon: "The Lord is with you, you mighty man of valor" (12)

> Where we see what is, God sees what can be.



Judges 6 Israel cries out, God answers. Angel of the Lord to Gideon "Go in this might of yours, and you shall save Israel . . . Have I not sent you?" Israel was not saved, delivered, blessed so they could hide in dens and caves.



Judges 6 Gideon's answer to God: "Where have you been?" (13) Isa. 59:1-2 – Sin separates. Look at your life. Trust that God knows, cares, will deliver in His own way and time.



Judges 6 Gideon's answer to God: > "How can I?" (15) Moses: "Who am I?"; "What if?" While we are busy making excuses, God is busy making plans.



Judges 6 God's answer to Gideon: "The Lord is with you." (12, 14, 16) "I will never leave you nor forsake you." "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me."



Judges 6 God's prerequisites for Gideon: Remove the altar of Baal. Build an altar to God. God has no use for divided loyalty. 2 Cor. 6:14-7:1 – Separate, do not touch, cleanse, perfect holiness.
