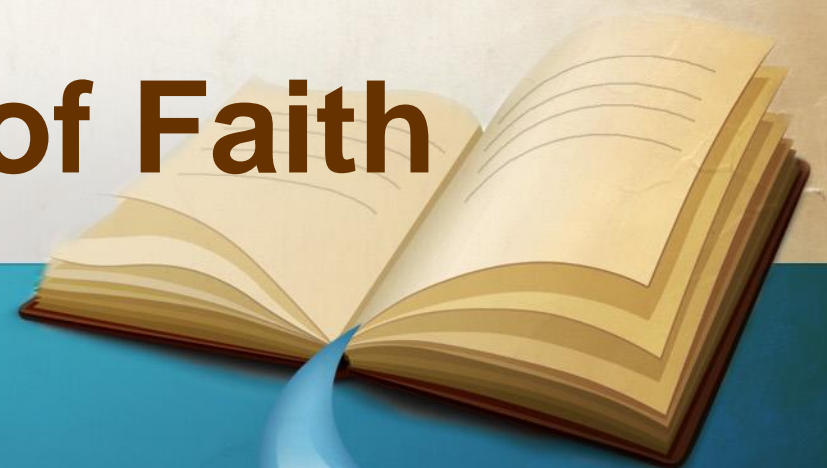

“Behold, the Lamb of God”

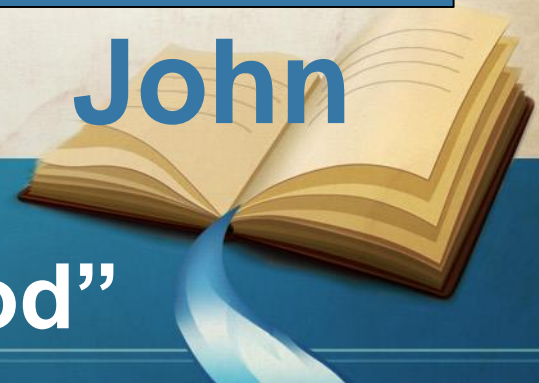
Someone is coming – John 1.19-28

The Jews had long anticipated the coming of the Messiah (Christ)

John did not take the opportunity to glorify himself

John's purpose was to prepare the way of the Lord

“Behold, the Lamb of God” **– John 1.29-34**

The figure of a lamb was connected to the redemption of sin

John recognized Jesus’ authority and deity

John testified about Jesus as an eyewitness

Jesus’ invitation is simple

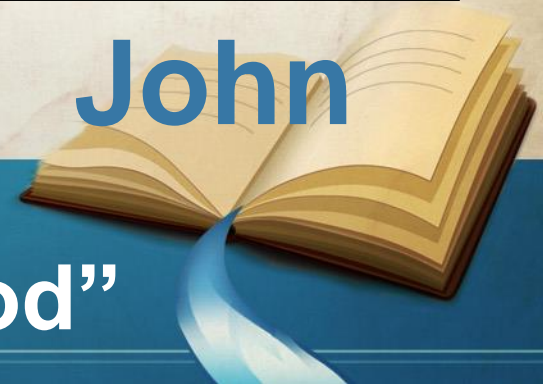
“You are the Son of God, You are the King of Israel” – John 1.47-51
