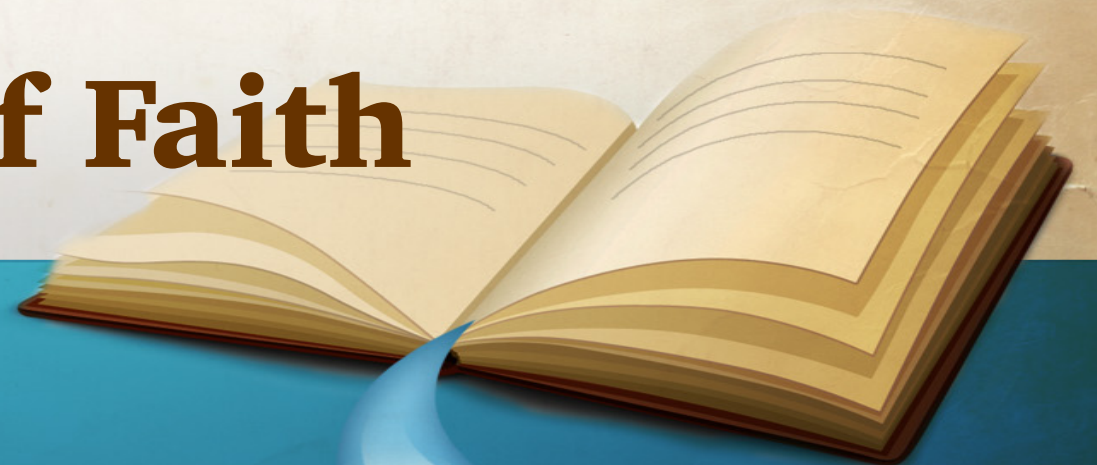

# The Death of Lazarus

- **“Let’s go to Judea again”**
  - The love of Jesus was evident in what He was willing to do.
- **“It is for the glory of God”**

  - Jesus hoped to inspire faith in His disciples.

  - Physical death is not the end for the believer.
- **“Jesus wept”**
  - Short but powerful, Jesus cares deeply for His people.

# Jesus Raises Lazarus

- **“Then Jesus, deeply moved again, came to the tomb”**
  - The love of Jesus motivates Him to action.
- **“If you believe you would see the glory of God”**
  - By faith we have access to the power of God.
- **“Lazarus come out”**
  - Jesus raises Lazarus by the power of His word.

# The Plot of the Jews
