- > "Let's go to Judea again"

Jesus Meets Martha and Mary

- > "Your brother will rise again"
 - Jesus intended to raise Lazarus from the dead.
- > "Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live"
 - Physical death is not the end for the believer.
- > "Jesus wept"
 - Short but powerful, Jesus cares deeply for His people.



Jesus Raises Lazarus

- > "Then Jesus, deeply moved again, came to the tomb"
 - The love of Jesus motivates Him to action.
- > "If you believe you would see the glory of God"
 - By faith we have access to the power of God.
- "Lazarus come out"
 - Jesus raises Lazarus by the power of His word.



The Plot of the Jews

- > "If we let Him go on like this everyone will believe in Him"
 - The Jews recognized the power of Jesus miracles to produce faith.
- > "It is better that one man should die for the people"
 - Christ's love would be shown through His willingness to die for all.
- > "To gather into one the children of God"
 - Jesus would bring new life to His people.
