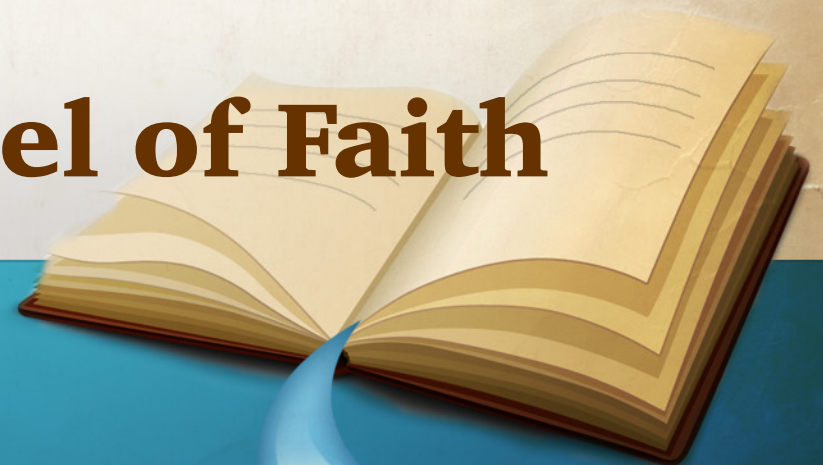

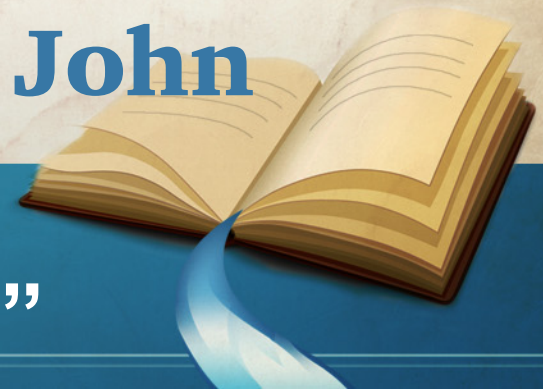
Lesson 17:

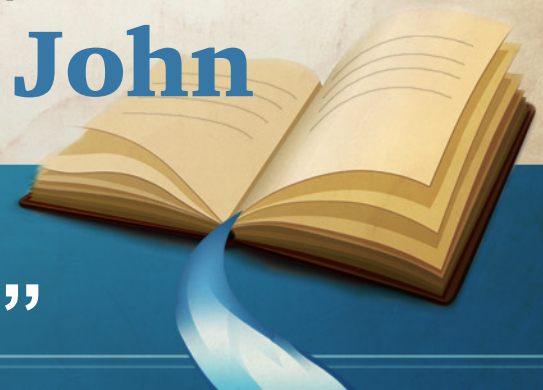
Lesson 17:

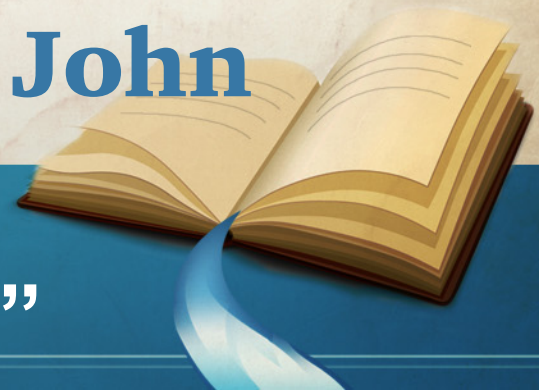
