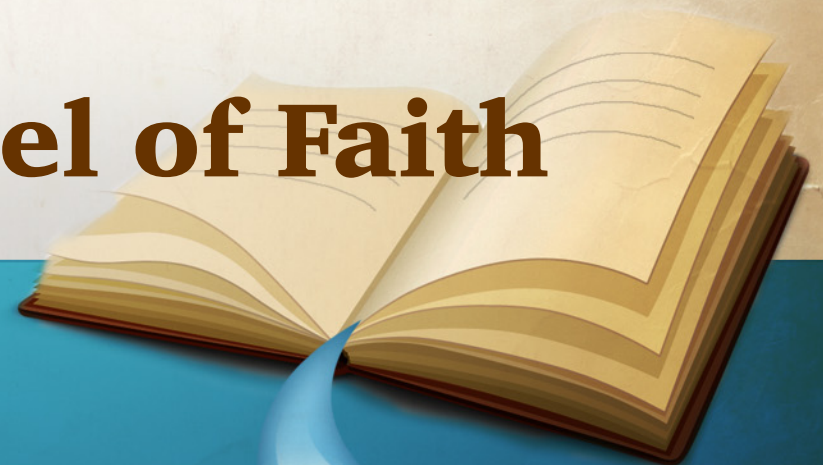

# **The Betrayal of Jesus by Judas**

## **– John 18.1-11**

- **“Knowing all that would happen” v. 4**
  - Jesus knew of the imminent suffering.
- **“I am he” v. 5**
  - Jesus identifies Himself.
- **“Shall I not drink the cup...?” v. 11**
  - Jesus willingly accepted his role.

# The Arrest of Jesus by the Jews

## – John 18.12-27

- **“Expedient that one man should die.” v. 14**
  - Jesus’ willing death would save the world.
- **“Peter again denied it” vv. 17, 25, 27**
  - Represents man’s sad lack of faith.
- **“Ask those who heard me” v. 21**
  - His teaching could be confirmed.

# The Hearing of Jesus by Pilate – John 18.28-40

- **“Are you the king of the Jews?” v. 33**
  - Pilate examines the charge.
- **“For this purpose I have come...” v. 37**
  - Jesus came to bear witness to the truth.
- **“Not this man, but Barabbas!” v. 40**
  - Underscores the rejection of Jesus.
