

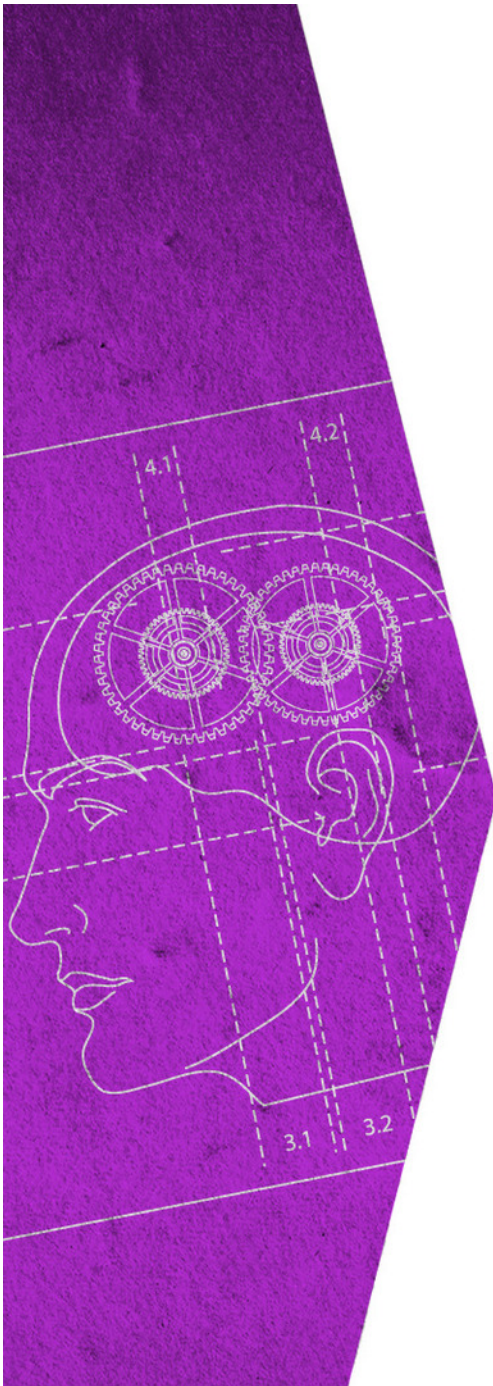


# **What Was Cain Thinking?**

# Possibility #1 – He wasn't thinking.

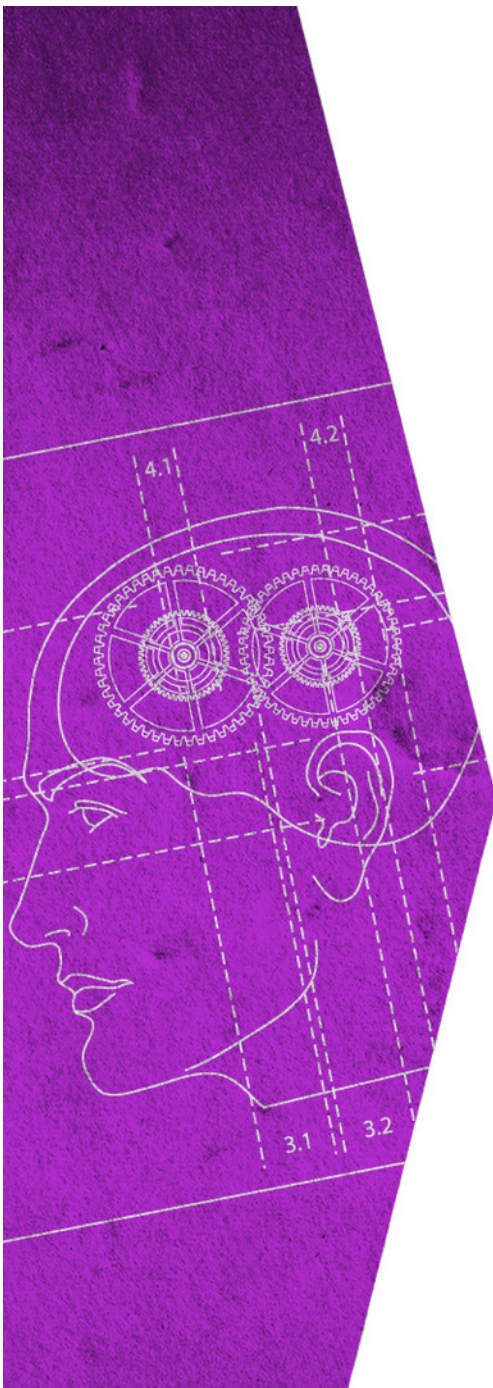
- **Rom. 1:18-23, 28 – Quit thinking about God.**
- **Jude 10 – Like unreasoning animals.**
- **Dan. 4:30-32 – Nebuchadnezzar made to think about God.**



# **Possibility #1 – He wasn't thinking.**

## **Message for us: THINK!**

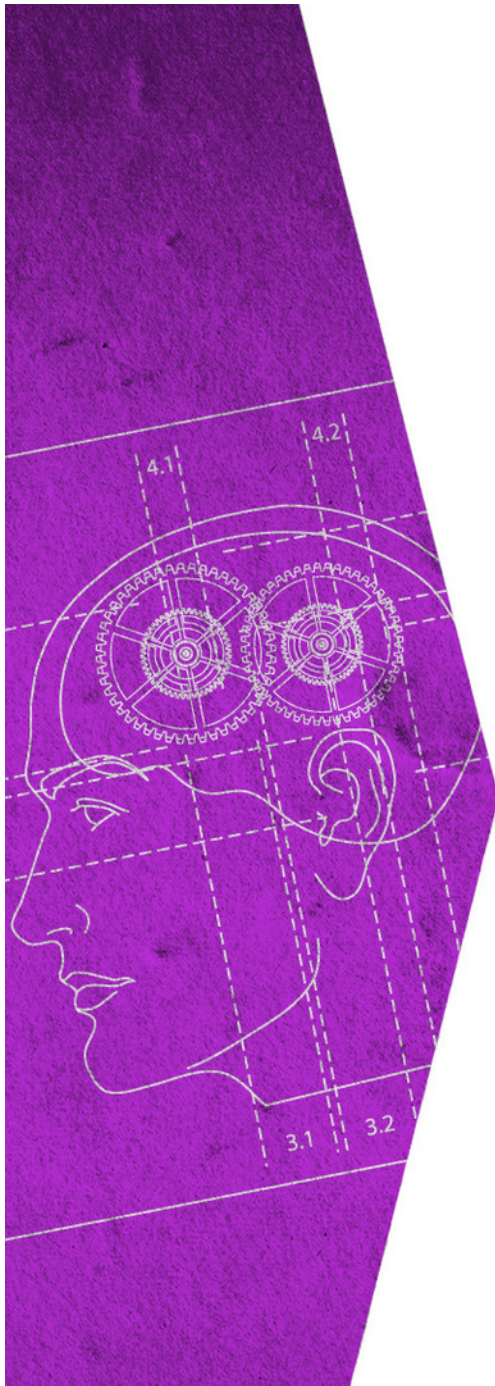
- **About God and His will for us.**
- **About consequences of our actions.**
- **About heaven and hell.**



# Possibility #1 – He wasn't thinking.

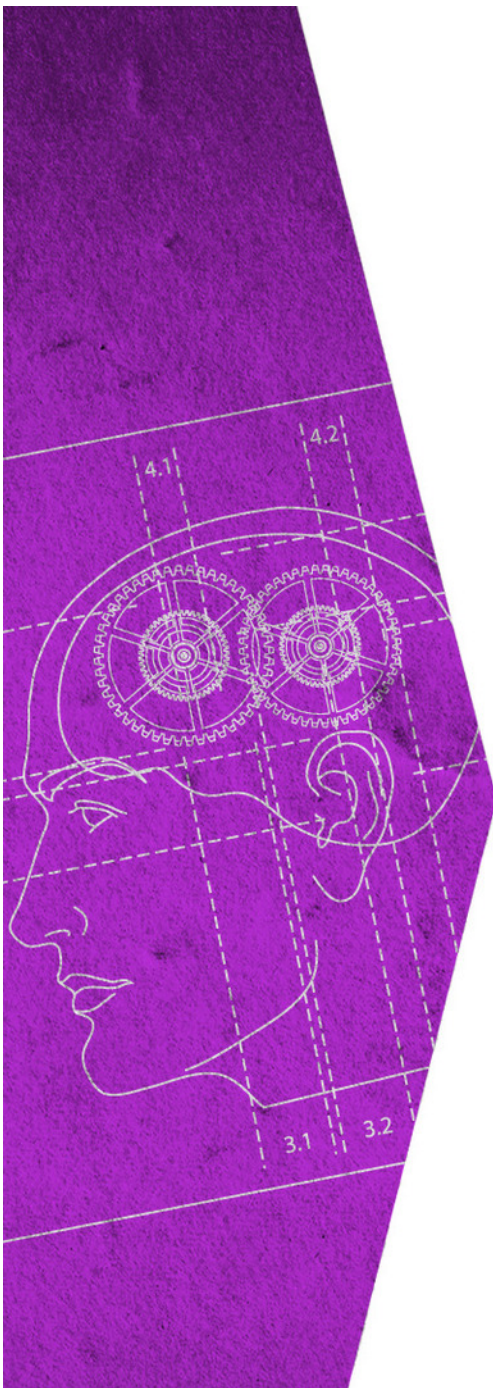
## Why would we NOT think?

- **Luke 12:29-31; 14:16-24 – Too busy with other things.**
- **2 Sam. 6:6-7 – Allow oneself to get into situation where there is no time to think.**
- **2 Sam. 11 – Allow oneself to get into situation where thinking right is too difficult.**



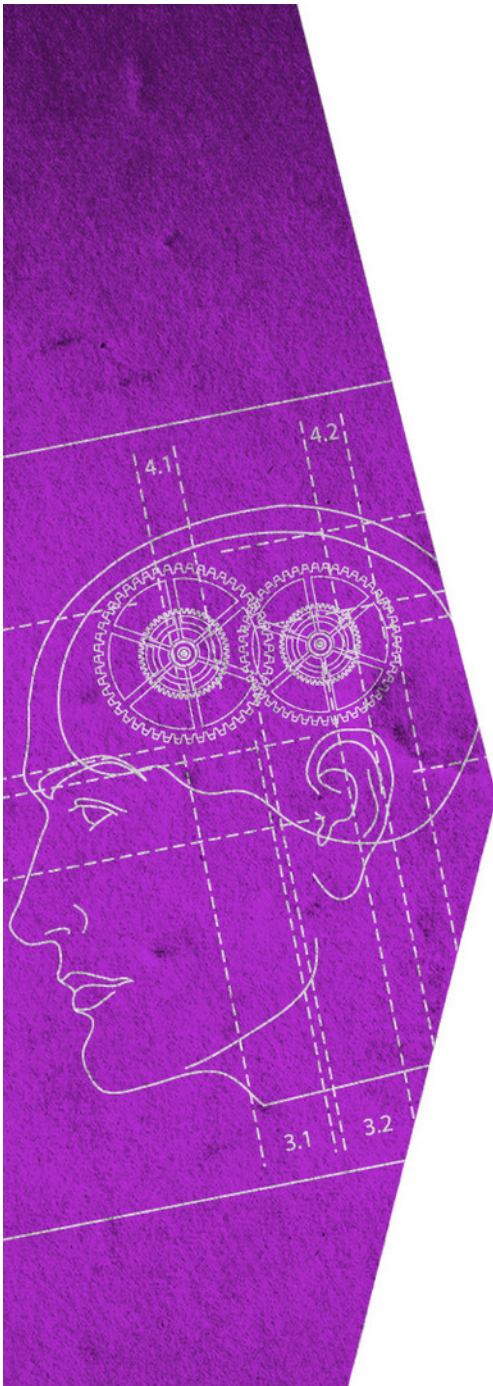
**Possibility #1 –

**Phil. 4:8 -  
“Think (meditate)  
on these things.”**



# Possibility #2 – He was thinking too much.

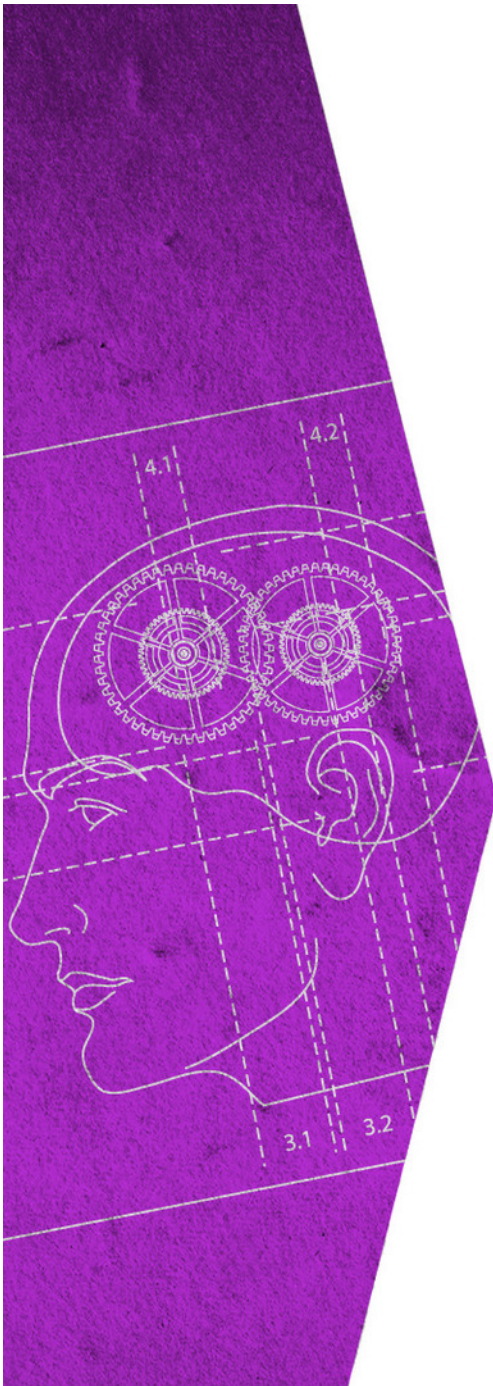
- 2 John 9 – Not abiding in the doctrine of Christ.
- Mat. 3:9 – Pedigree.
- Mat. 5:17 – Preconceptions.
- Mat. 6:7 – Impressing God.
- Mat. 10:34 – Jesus' mission.
- Luke 13:1-5 – Suppositions.
- John 16:2 – Service to God.



# Possibility #2 – He was thinking too much.

## Why think too much?

- **1 Sam. 15:21, 24 – Pressure from others.**
- **Acts 26:4-5, 9 – Long held positions of men.**
- **2 Kings 5:11 – Pride.**
