**Acts 20:21** - Toward God

**2 Tim. 2:25-26** - “Come to their  
senses”

What Jesus said about it:

Sinners need it, and He called sinners to it.

**Mat. 9:13; Mark 1:15**

Sinners who do not repent will perish.

**Luke 13:5**

Joy in heaven over one penitent sinner.

**Luke 15:10**

Told apostles to preach it to all nations.

**Luke 24:47**

What Jesus said about it:

It is clear that Jesus expected the gospel to bring the listener to repentance.

Jesus expected sinners to undergo a radical, life-altering change of mind, and He would accept nothing less.

# The Three-Step Process of Repentance

You Sorrow - 2 Cor. 7:9-10

You Resolve - 2 Cor. 7:11a

You Change - 2 Cor. 7:11b, 13-16

Luke 3:8 - “fruits worthy of repentance”

Acts 26:20 - “works befitting repentance”
